Each year during the Asian Business Association's Annual Scholarship & Awards Gala, the ABA Foundation awards a minimum of (2) \$1,000 scholarships to well deserving students. Applicant Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant shall be eligible under one or more of the following conditions:
 - High school graduating class of 2022
 - · Current high school graduate
 - · Current undergraduate college student
- 2. Applicant shall have a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average.
- 3. Applicant must reside in San Diego County.
- 4. Applicant must be a United States citizen or permanent resident.

ABA Scholarship Guidelines:

- Scholarships are awarded only to students who attend or will be attending accredited institutions of higher learning. Scholarships are based on the type of institution the student is attending (Community College, University, Trade School, etc.). In the event the student changes the type of educational institution they are attending, the scholarship shall be forfeited.
- 2. The ABA Scholarship Committee Judges, using a blind rating system, shall select the recipients of ABA scholarships. All decisions of the Committee Judges shall be final.
- 3. Application forms are available at www.abasd.org
- 4. A completed application will consist of the following:
 - Completed electronic application form
 - Personal narrative not to exceed 2 pages, 1.5 spaced, using 12 point font, as .doc or .pdf, emailed to information@abasd.org as an attachment.
 - Copy of transcript confirming a grade point average of 3.0 or better.
 - Proof of United States citizenship or Permanent Resident status.
 - Applications must be received by 5PM on June 30, 2022. Incomplete applications will be ineligible.
- 5. Scholarship recipients may elect to have scholarship awards paid directly to them, or to the appropriate Educational Institution. Proof of enrollment will be required before payment is made.
- 6. The ABA Scholarship committee reserves the right to make any changes to these guidelines. No changes shall be allowed after May 13th.
